- Over 100 grocery bags FULL of non-perishable food items were donated, locally, via the Thrivent Financial/Finnegans "Reverse Food Truck" parked in the Oakwood Lot
- ❖ 15 ponytails of hair total were donated for Pantene Beautiful Lengths via American Cancer Society (12 ponytails) and Locks of Love (3 ponytails)
- ❖ 200+ dog and cat toys were made for rescue animals and donated to Adopt-a-Pet Shop
- ❖ 133 Emergency Quick-Release Paracord Bracelets will be sent to US troops via Operation Gratitude
- ❖ 567! sandwiches delivered to Marie Sandvik Center to feed the homeless
- Over 100 Comfort Kits for children were delivered to the Sojourner Project shelter
- ❖ 85 Chemo Kits for kids going through treatment at MN Children's Hospital
- 44 Rice Heating Pads crafted to provide warmth for elderly residents at Cornerstone Commons
- 88 Soup Kits for families in need (via PRISM in Golden Valley)
- Raised \$461.51 in the grade Coin Challenge run by the Student Council and funds were donated to IOCP (4<sup>th</sup> grade won the challenge congrats!)
- Raised \$238.00 at the Snack Stand run by the Student Council and funds were used to buy toys and games for kids in need at the *Holiday Toy Shoppe* event on 12-18 (PRISM in Golden Valley)
