

Oakwood Family Service Night

Thanks to all who attended Oakwood's 11th annual **Family Service Night!**

We had another successful year with **over 600 attendees**

(not including the 57 volunteers, Student Council, or the community partners who joined us)!

**As a community, we used our resources and hands to help others.
Here is what we accomplished together:**

- ❖ **215 pounds of non-perishable food** donated to the Interfaith Outreach food shelf
- ❖ **110 dog toys and 6 blankets** made for rescue animals trained to assist veterans through Pets for Vets
- ❖ **89 emergency quick-release paracord bracelets** created and sent to US troops through Operation Gratitude
- ❖ **221 care kits** assembled for kids undergoing chemotherapy at Children's Hospital of MN
- ❖ **247 meal kit items** (decorated bags & utensil kits) created for the Wayzata-Plymouth Meals on Wheels program
- ❖ **75 key chains** created to welcome families to Home Free Women's Shelter in Plymouth
- ❖ **Over 30 reusable shopping bags** created from old t-shirts to reduce plastic bag consumption by our community
- ❖ **\$364 raised by the Coin Challenge/Snack Stand** (both run by the Student Council). This will be donated to St. Jude's (and, this year, the 1st graders won the Coin War and the party!)
